This information is important so that we may properly group your essay for judging, as well as to notify you if you are a winner. **Essays that are submitted without a completed cover sheet may be rejected!**

When researching your information, you may use all sources including the internet. However, **no computer generated essays are permitted.** Be creative and use this contest to further enhance your educational experience.

The essay requirements are as follows: (Typed entries are preferred from 6th grade up)

- 4th to 5th grades.....1 page
- 6th to 8th grades.....2 pages
- High School.....2 to 3 pages
- College.....3 pages (include a copy of your current roster)

The award amounts for 1st Place in the categories are:

- 4th to 5th Grades.....\$350
- 6th to 8th Grades.....\$550
- High School..... \$750
- College.....\$1000

Entries must be mailed through the US Postal Mail System and be postmarked by Wednesday, May 11, 2022.
